1. CCITS Web-Site Reminder (http://www.iteris.com/ccits-admin/)

2. ITS Outreach Materials

- CCITS Brochure
 - ➤ Brochure is 100% complete
 - ➤ An additional 500 copies (1,500 total) to be printed with extra cost (\$115) to be split evenly between SBCAG & Caltrans D5
 - > Target print date is December 23rd, 2005
 - Provision to CCITS Agencies by mid-January 2006
 - Discussion re: timing of brochure re: current status in the Architecture process & lack of Emergency Management projects
 - Noted that this is an update to the CCITS Architecture & Brochure & that all Agencies have already reviewed/approved content
 - Need to ensure that Emergency Management projects are addressed/included w/in upcoming Video, DVD Fact Sheet, & CCITS Architecture
- CCITS Video/DVD
 - Formed CCITS Video Sub-Committee
 - Kathy Urlie (AMBAG)
 - > Tim Rochte (Caltrans D5)
 - Andrew Orfila (SBCAG)
 - ➤ Tom Hiltner (SCMTD)
 - Additional members accepted thru December 31st, 2005
 - Version/Length
 - ➤ AMBAG motioned, TAMC 2nd, & the CCITS Coordinating Group agreed that the length of the updated CCITS video/DVD will be approx. 5-7 minutes
 - Content
 - Original 2000 CCITS video will be used as the basis for the updated script & video/DVD
 - ➤ Focus will be on the broad types of ITS applications in the Central Coast (CMS, Caltrans D5 TMC, etc.)
 - > TRG will ensure that Emergency Management is highlighted
 - > TRG will reduce the CCITS Regional background material, meeting shots, building shots, etc.
 - Additional content ideas accepted thru December 31st, 2005 (Comment Disposition Form)

> Schedule

- > 1/6/06 TRG submits 1st draft script/storyboard to subcommittee
- ➤ 1/13/05 Sub-committee submits comments to TRG
- ➤ 1/20/05 TRG submits 2nd draft script/storyboard
- ➤ 1/27/05 Sub-committee submits comments to TRG
- 2/3/06 TRG submits final script/storyboard
- ➤ Feb '06 Caltrans Film Crew begins shooting additional footage (please note that Caltrans needs 2-week lead time)
- ➤ Mar '06 Additional filming, editing, & compilation of draft video
- Apr '06 Viewing of draft video at next CCITS meeting
- > AMBAG to keep CCITS Coordinating Group apprised of status/events
- "Insert/Fact Sheet" will be a fold-out distillation of the CCITS Brochure & video/DVD

3. Regional ITS Architecture

- System Inventory
 - Comments
 - > **Due by December 31st, 2005** (afterwards, additions/changes will be handled per the Architecture Maintenance Plan)
 - Santa Cruz County comments due following TTAC review in Jan '06
 - TransCore requested that the CCITS Coordinating Group use the "Comment Disposition Form" for ALL document reviews (
 - Available on CCITS project web-site)
 - TransCore to post disposition to web-site

Call Boxes

- All Counties (except San Benito) have or are in the process of switching call box processing to private firms (Private Call Answering Center), not CHP
- Caltrans HQ proposed a research project re: call box answering services & the possibility of using a single provider for the Central Coast
- Discussion of "Status" Options
 - Currently using standard "Existing" & "Planned"
 - TransCore will migrate inventory to "Existing" (currently inplace/use), "Programmed" (funded w/in TIP/budget), & "Planned" based upon existing CCITS Coordinating Group comments & forthcoming input
- Operational Concepts (Roles & Responsibilities)
 - Please note that the Turbo Architecture report is NOT the Working Paper deliverable (but will be incorporated into such)
 - > Comments due January 27th, 2006 (Comment Disposition Form)
 - > FHWA stressed the importance of this piece of the CCITS Architecture
 - Use Agency constituency "cheat sheet" to help identify areas to review

- Functional Requirements
 - Please note that the Turbo Architecture report is NOT the Working Paper deliverable (but will be incorporated into such)
 - > Comments due January 27th, 2006 (Comment Disposition Form)
- Interconnects/Flows
 - ➤ Initial development based on "original" 2000 CCITS Architecture & "new" Operational Concepts & Functional Requirements
 - > To begin in earnest after comments above incorporated
- ITS Project Sequencing
 - To be identified on a per County basis
 - Also, identify on a CCITS Regional basis
- Turbo Database
 - Current functionality of Turbo & CCITS Architecture database may not support the desire to distribute individual County sub-architectures
 - FHWA agreed that the current structure will suffice for MPO Architecture requirements, but will reserve final judgment until later in the process
 - TransCore, Caltrans, AMBAG, SBCAG, & FHWA conducted a telcon on December 16th, 2005 to discuss the current CCITS Turbo database structure, its implications, & potential options
 - TransCore to partition CCITS Turbo database into three (3) constituent MPO Turbo databases (SBCAG, SLOCOG, & AMBAG);
 - Each w/ applicable local, (locally-deployed) Caltrans,
 & sub-Regionally significant elements, etc.
 - Current Architecture Maintenance Plans still support the revised structure
 - TransCore to document potential maintenance (primarily import-related) issues due to the revised structure
 - MPOs (w/ input from FHWA & Caltrans) to determine need/desire for an additional CCITS Regional Turbo database (ASAP)
 - Caltrans HQ is in the process of distilling the CA Statewide ITS Architecture into District Architectures
 - FHWA & Caltrans to inform TransCore & the MPOs re: any Turbo database import-related issues that they have encountered/resolved
 - If possible, such should be available to the Central Coast at no charge

4. Architecture Maintenance Plan

- FINAL documents are DONE
- Still need response from Caltrans re: "lead role" re: maintenance of the CCITS Regional Architecture
 - ▶ 12/16/05 Caltrans D5 to discuss w/ upper management
 - For CCITS Regional MP, replace named individual(s) w/ Title/Position

5. Turbo Training

- Sept '05 Caltrans hosted Turbo training
- Some CCITS participants were unable to attend due to schedule conflicts & requested that additional sessions be scheduled
- Please note that this CCITS Study includes Turbo "shadow training" (hands-on)
 & that training will be touched upon w/in the Architecture Implementation Guide

6. Project Schedule

 After OK by Caltrans & FHWA, the CCITS Coordinating Group approved a 6month project extension to December 31st, 2006

7. Agency Agreements

- General objective should be to develop flexible agreement templates
- Potential template ideas/options
 - SBCAG (& others) would like to be able to stream Caltrans' CCTV images on their websites
 - ➤ TAMC would like to see transit signal priority/pre-emption
 - SLOCOG would like to see traffic signal synchronization
 - Consider public/private partnerships (e.g., use of private CMS for Amber Alert, access to ROW, etc.)
 - CCITS Coordinating Group to provide comments on "List of Agreements" matrix & identify "Top 5" types of agreement templates needed by January 6th, 2006 (Comment Disposition Form)
- Caltrans has some specific items that need to be addressed w/in their MOUs & such language should be used as a foundation & streamlined into the Central Coast (as possible)

8. Architecture Implementation Guide/Plan

- Outline submitted late-Oct '05 & revised based upon comments received
- TransCore to re-submit revised outline (post to web-site) by December 23rd, 2005
- TransCore targeting January 27th, 2006 for draft (pending CCITS Turbo database structure efforts)

9. Agency Updates

- Updates from CCITS Coordinating Group members regarding their Agency's ITSrelated activities, including:
 - Arroyo Grande seeking funding for advanced crosswalk on Hwy 127
 - SLOCOG Board rejected SHOPP-funded ITS Project (not an ITS-related issue, but outreach materials could help)
 - Reminder that TransCore can/will assist w/ ITS educational presentations to various Boards
 - Caltrans added 2 new CCTV cameras along US 101 in Goleta & Pismo Beach (& are available on-line)
 - Amtrak to be installing new Next Train CMS & ticket vending machines in the LOSSAN corridor
 - ➤ ITS a component of a US101 Corridor Study in Santa Barbara (needs funding tho)

- South Santa Barbara County US 101 improvement project includes ITS Projects (funded)
- > State Systems Engineering Guidebook & training are being updated
- > Santa Cruz Metro Transit Trip Planning project may get programmed in Jan '06 for funding in July '07
- Santa Cruz County call box upgrade project is continuing; considering Smart Call Boxes & CCTV
- > Caltrans adding ITS to SR 17 improvements in Santa Cruz County
