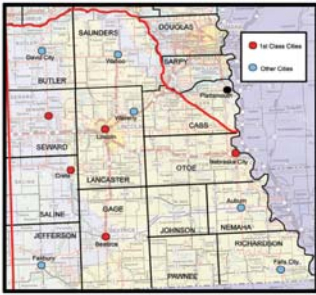

From the East: Hwy 2 to 14th Street. South about two miles to Walt Library on west side of street.

From the West and North: US 77 to Van Dorn Street exit. East to Hwy 2. South to 14th Street. South on 14th Street about two miles to Walt Library on west side of street.

From the South: US 77 to Warlick. East on Warlick to 14th Street. South on 14th Street about one mile to Walt Library on west side of the street.
